The Canton Township Board of Trustees met in a Regular Session on

Regular Meeting – June 23, 2020

Mr. Mittas made a motion to approve and waive the reading of the minutes from the June 23, 2020 Regular Meeting. Motion seconded by Mr. Nichols and voting YES – Mr. Shaffer, Mr. Mittas and Mr. Nichols.

Fire Chief presented receipts for two weeks for the following: \$4,202.31 = Ambulance Billing, and \$953.00=Fire Prevention for total receipts of \$5,155.31.
