


Road News

The Zoning Commission is a quasi-legislative body established by statute and its function is to:

- 1. Establish and amend the Township Zoning Resolution.
- 2. Establish and amend the Official Zoning Map.

The Board declared the following properties nuisances as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87 and the Canton Township Property Maintenance Code. 1114 Oak Ave NW, 302- 30th St SW, 2918 25th St SE and 3116- 38th St SW all for trash/debris. 2635 6th St SE, 523 Cole Ave SE and Eastend Ave SE all for no permit for accessory building.

The Board of Trustees will conducted a public hearing on December 8, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. to consider the reclassification of property of 2714 Waynesburg Dr SE from a B2- Neighborhood Business to a B3- Commercial Business.
