Fire Department News

The Canton Township Fire Department received an EMS Grant for \$2,846.43.

Road Department News

A letter of intent was signed to purchase a 2021 Freightliner dump truck equipped with a snow and ice removal package. Delivery from ARM is expected by September/ October.

The Stark County Engineer safety study confirmed the need for a three-way stop at the intersection of Sherer and Prairie College due to line of sight concerns.

The Board approved a resolution requesting ODOT to post no engine brake signs in the vicinity of the Route 800 and Faircrest intersection.

The Public Works Director updated the Board on the new electronic speed sign that has arrived and is being mounted on a portable trailer. An update was also received on the existing dump truck used bed swap and new cab on chassis to prolong their useful life as part of the township fleet. Thanks to the Road Department Mechanic and other staff that assisted.

The new Ventrac mower is expected to be delivered this week. This is good news as the only mower utilized for nuisance mows and park/ township maintenance has suffered repeated mechanical failures and has been out of service.
