

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Board of Trustees of Canton Township, Stark County, on November 18, 2014, adopted a Resolution, that pursuant to the express authority of RC 505.17(B)(1) to designate the Canton Township Road Superintendent as the person authorized to issue an order declaring a snow emergency limiting or preventing parking on any township road, street, or highway during the snow emergency, within Canton Township.

The Canton Township Road Superintendent shall only declare a snow emergency when the natural accumulation of snowfall is two (2) inches or greater; and, that pursuant to the specific authority of RC 505.17(B)(2) that the Canton Township Road Superintendent may make an announcement of a snow emergency parking ban to the local news media. Two (2) hours after the request to the local news media to announce that a snow emergency has been declared, the snow emergency parking ban shall become effective and shall remain in effect for a specified period of time or indefinitely and until canceled by a subsequent announcement to the local news media.

The Canton Township Road Superintendent may order towed and placed into storage any vehicle parked in violation of the snow emergency resolution. The owner or any lien holder of the vehicle ordered into storage may claim the vehicle upon presentation of proof of ownership and payment of all expenses, charges, fines and costs incurred as a result of the parking violation and removal and storage of the vehicle. Under RC 505.17(E) whoever violates this resolution is guilty of a minor misdemeanor and that the fines levied and collected under this section shall be paid into the Canton Township general fund.
